GLEAM, Art in a New Light features a local, national and international group of artists creating light-based installations in the outdoor gardens and the Bolz Conservatory. GLEAM 2018 introduces new lighting techniques and interactive projects and allows the artists' vivid imaginations to enrich our own. GLEAM is a major fundraiser for the Gardens. Average annual attendance for this 2-month exhibit is 10,000.

The GLEAM admission cashiers provide general exhibit information and processes event admissions with cash, checks or credit cards using a touch screen Clover system.

The GLEAM gift shop cashiers process retail purchases in Olbrich's Growing Gifts Shop during the exhibit viewings. Applicants must be friendly, out-going, able to project their voice and willing to work in both areas. This position involves constant interaction with the general public. Training is provided. There is potential for additional hours throughout the year during special events and as needed.

- Promote respectful and responsible enjoyment of the exhibits
