EDUCATION PROGRAM SUPPORT

Spreading our Wings – As part of Olbrich's 20th anniversary of Blooming Butterflies, we partnered with Dane Arts Mural Arts and the Madison Metropolitan School District to craft and paint

seven sets of beautiful butterfly wings to be placed throughout the Gardens. Help these wings take flight this summer and support our proud partnership! – \$1,000

Puppets Aplenty – Purchase a puppet collection for Olbrich's Little Sprouts Story & Stroll and family classes, and enhance story time for our early learners! 


ENHANCE THE GARDENS

Have a Seat in the Herb Garden –

Olbrich's interactive and fragrant Herb Garden is a hub of activity year-round, and participates in many important programs, including Goodman Community Center's Summer Seed to Table efforts. A newly-created patio needs seating so visitors can enjoy the splendor of the garden. You can donate two artisanal chairs, designed to remain outside year-round, made from Wisconsin-grown wood that was sustainably harvested. – \$5,000

Light the Way – In 2018, GLEAM: Art in a New Light welcomed more than 13,000 visitors! Install new landscape lighting to improve navigation for GLEAM, providing pathways to light-based installations throughout the gardens. – \$3,000
