pencil/eraser

metal straight edge - preferred, wood with metal edge will work

Utility Knife and/or x-acto knife and cutting matt (extra blades are helpful)

Sobo , Eileen's Tacky glue, or PVA glue (4 - 8 oz.) whatever you have

a couple small containers for water/glue, (yogurt or margarine size)

glue brush - if you have one, I will have some available to share

glue stick

small T-square, plastic triangle - if you have

Personal choice of decorative papers - these may be ones you have made in suminagashi or paste papers, etc.

A variety of commercially available papers will be offered for choices as well. It is nice to have some decorative and some plain to combine - these will be individual choices.

Bring small jewelry type boxes if you have some. These are helpful for beginning, to understand the processes/techniques. We will also start from a flat surface to construct a box design, this will be provided.
